

关于报考新西兰怀卡托大学 3/3.5+1/1.5 本硕连读项目的通知

根据新西兰怀卡托大学(The University of Waikato)与贵校签署的协议备忘录,我校愿意为贵校学生提供报考本硕连读项目特殊申报通道。

一、项目基本介绍

3/3.5+1/1.5 即学生在 3 年或者 3.5 年内完成除毕业论文或毕业设计以外的所有本科课程,且学院允许学生在海外完成毕业论文或毕业设计并出具成绩单及说明材料的前提下,学生可以开始在新西兰怀卡托大学攻读 1/1.5 年硕士课程。

二、报名条件

1、学术成绩要求

学生本科平均成绩为 B (75 分及以上), 个别要求本科平均成绩为 B- (70 分及以上)。

2、英语成绩要求

雅思(学术类)总分6.5 (各单项不低于6.0)或

托福总分90, 且写作不低于21或

PTE (学术类) 总分 56. 且 PTE 交际技能分数不低于 46. 或

参加新西兰怀卡托大学认可的 Academic English Level 5 课程学习,或

怀卡托大学接受的其它英语能力证明。

3、学校支持函

学校须为拟申请本项目的学生出具支持函,确认学生已完成除论文或毕业设计以外所有课程,且根据进度,预计学生可以完成论文或毕业设计,并顺利毕业。

* 请注意:如因任何原因学生未能取得本科学士学位,怀卡托大学无法为其颁发硕士学位。

三、新西兰怀卡托大学奖学金

- GPA 达到 B+ (新西兰怀卡托大学标准为 80 分)及以上的同学可申请合作项目奖学金,数额 5000 10000 新元的奖学金(全日制注册 180 及以上学分的硕士学位课程);
- 未达到 B+的同学可获得 3000 新元的合作项目学费减免。

四、 Academic English Level 5 课程介绍

1、学习步骤:申请语言入学测试→测试通过入读课程→学习完成获得成绩单

2、学习时长: 12 周

3、学习方式:线上或者校内线下(根据报名人数)


